Section 1 (135A.1365) requires the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities to provide students with access to menstrual products at no charge. The products must be available in restrooms used by students. The University of Minnesota is requested to do the same. "Menstrual products" is defined.

Section 2 provides a blank appropriation to the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities and the University of Minnesota for purposes of section 1.
