Statewide Stable Housing Mediation Grant Program

HF1215 establishes a housing mediation grant program to support renters and residential rental property owners; \$4,000,000 (\$2,000,000 annually) in fiscal year 2023.

Stable housing is the cornerstone of a safe and stable community, and housing mediation provides an avenue for both renters and property owners to maintain that stability.

Expanding access to mediation services will help to reduce the negative consequences of evictions for families, schools, employers, neighborhoods, and communities.
