S.F. No. 925 – Medical Assistance Reimbursement for Parents and Spouses Providing Services

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Section 1 [256B.4911, subdivision 6] increases the total number of hours in a week for which parents of a minor or a spouse may be paid to provide personal assistance services under the consumer-directed community supports option from 40 total hours to 80 hours when more than one parent is providing service (provided no single parent provides more than 40 hours), 60 hours when only one parent is providing service, and 60 hours for a spouse.

Section 2 (256B.85, subdivision 7) makes a conforming change.

Section 3 [256B.85, subdivision 7b] increases the total number of hours in a week for which parents of a minor or a spouse may be paid to provide community first services and supports from 40 total hours to 80 hours when more than one parent is providing service (provided no single parent provides more than 40 hours), 60 hours when only one parent is providing service, and 60 hours for a spouse.
