

1.1 Senator ..... moves to amend S.F. No. 1615 as follows:

1.2 Page 4, after line 29, insert:

1.3 "Sec. 4. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 256B.0941, subdivision 2a, is amended to read:

1.4 Subd. 2a. **Sleeping hours.** During normal sleeping hours, a psychiatric residential  
1.5 treatment facility provider must provide at least one staff person for every six residents  
1.6 present within a living unit. A provider must adjust sleeping-hour staffing levels based on  
1.7 the clinical needs of the residents in the facility. Sleeping hours must include at least one  
1.8 staff trained and certified to provide emergency medical response. During normal sleeping  
1.9 hours, a registered nurse must be available on call to assess a child's needs and must be  
1.10 available within 60 minutes.

1.11 Sec. 5. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 256B.0941, is amended by adding a subdivision  
1.12 to read:

1.13 Subd. 2b. **Shared site.** Related services that have a bright line separation from psychiatric  
1.14 residential treatment facility service operations may be delivered in the same facility,  
1.15 including under the same structural roof. In shared site settings, staff will provide services  
1.16 only to programs they are affiliated to through NetStudy."

1.17 Page 5, lines 7 to 11, delete the new language

1.18 Page 5, line 18, strike the second "and"

1.19 Page 5, line 20, strike the period and insert a semicolon

1.20 Page 5, after line 20, insert:

1.21 "(3) estimated additional staffing compensation costs, subject to review by the  
1.22 commissioner; and

1.23 (4) estimated new capital costs, subject to review by the commissioner."

1.24 Renumber the sections in sequence and correct the internal references

1.25 Amend the title accordingly
