

S.F. No. 1009 – Integrated community supports modification

Section 1 (245D.12) modifies provisions related to the settings in which integrated community supports (ICS) may be provided.

Paragraph (a) clarifies that ICS may be provided in multiple buildings of the same apartment complex on the same or adjoining property.

Paragraph (c) modifies the existing limit that only one license holder may provide ICS in a multifamily housing building provided the commissioner approves a site-specific review allowing multiple providers to provide ICS in the building.

Paragraph (d) allows multiple licensees to provide ICS and other residential services at the same address or apartment complex so long as the total number of units in the building or complex in which residential services are provided do not exceed 25% of the available units.

Paragraph (e) requires at least two unit in a multifamily housing building in which ICS are provided.
