S.F. 1637 increases the medical assistance eligibility income limit for older adults, adults with disabilities, and children with disabilities from 100 percent to 133 percent of the federal poverty guidelines. The proposed income limit for these populations would be equal to the income limits for parents and caretaker relatives of children 18 or younger, adults without children, and children 19 to 20 years old.
