

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 1483 as follows:

1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 256B.0625, subdivision 22, is amended to
1.4 read:

1.5 Subd. 22. **Hospice care.** (a) Medical assistance covers hospice care services under Public
1.6 Law 99-272, section 9505, to the extent authorized by rule, except that a recipient age 21
1.7 or under who elects to receive hospice services does not waive coverage for services that
1.8 are related to the treatment of the condition for which a diagnosis of terminal illness has
1.9 been made.

1.10 (b) Medical assistance covers room and board for persons receiving hospice services in
1.11 a community-based setting unless room and board expenses are otherwise covered under a
1.12 different section of this chapter or under chapter 256I. The payment rate for room and board
1.13 under this paragraph must be 33 percent of the Medicare rate for continuous home care
1.14 hospice services as published in the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services annual
1.15 final rule updating payments and policies for hospice care. Payment for hospice room and
1.16 board under this paragraph must be made from state funds.

1.17 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective January 1, 2024."
