

1.1 Senator moves to amend the delete-everything amendment (SCS2934A-1)
1.2 to S.F. No. 2934 as follows:

1.3 Page 10, delete lines 5 to 9

1.4 Page 10, line 10, delete "(d)" and insert "(b)"

1.5 Page 10, after line 10, insert:

1.6 "(c) "Technology" means:

1.7 (1) enabling technology, which is a device capable of live two-way communication or
1.8 engagement between a resident and direct support staff at a remote location; or

1.9 (2) monitoring technology, which is the use of equipment to oversee, monitor, and
1.10 supervise an individual who receives medical assistance waiver or alternative care services
1.11 under section 256B.0913, 256B.092, or chapter 256S."

1.12 Page 10, line 17, after "supervision" insert "; commissioner notification"

1.13 Page 10, line 19, delete "enabling"

1.14 Page 10, after line 19, insert:

1.15 "(2) notify the commissioner of the community residential setting's intent to use
1.16 technology in lieu of on-site staff. The notification must:

1.17 (i) indicate a start date for the use of technology; and

1.18 (ii) attest that all requirements under this section are met and policies required under
1.19 subdivision 4 are available upon request;"

1.20 Page 10, line 20, delete "(2)" and insert "(3)"

1.21 Page 10, line 22, delete "(3)" and insert "(4)"

1.22 Page 10, line 25, delete "(4)" and insert "(5)"

1.23 Page 10, after line 31, insert:

1.24 "(c) A license holder must notify the commissioner if remote overnight supervision
1.25 technology will no longer be used by the license holder.

1.26 (d) Upon receipt of notification of use of remote overnight supervision or discontinuation
1.27 of use of remote overnight supervision by a license holder, the commissioner shall notify
1.28 the county licensing agency and update the license."

1.29 Page 11, after line 17, insert:

- 2.1 "(c) When no physical presence response is completed for a three-month period, the
- 2.2 license holder must conduct a physical presence response drill. The effectiveness of the
- 2.3 response protocol must be reviewed and documented."
