Through participation in its trademarked Theory of Transformation™ (ToT) logic model, Ujamaa men achieve brotherhood, stability, and personal success.

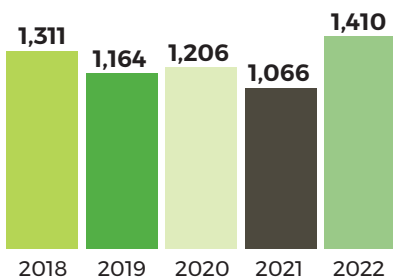
Upon enrolling, each participant goes through intake and evaluation with a high context coach, who develops an Individual Transformation Plan (ITP) designed to meet the transformation needs of each participant. In most cases, participants have experienced trauma as a result of extreme poverty, therefore, every step forward, no matter how small, is celebrated and the men are recognized for their self-determination. This is brotherhood.

Theory of Transformation™ Five Ultimate Outcomes:

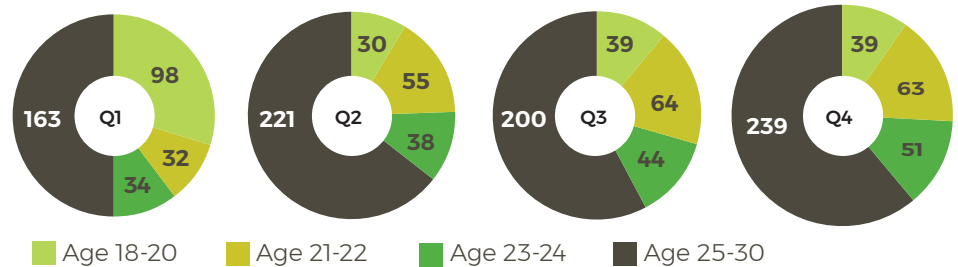
1. Stable Housing Situation

2022 THEORY OF TRANSFORMATION DEMOGRAPHIC DATA (CUMULATIVE)

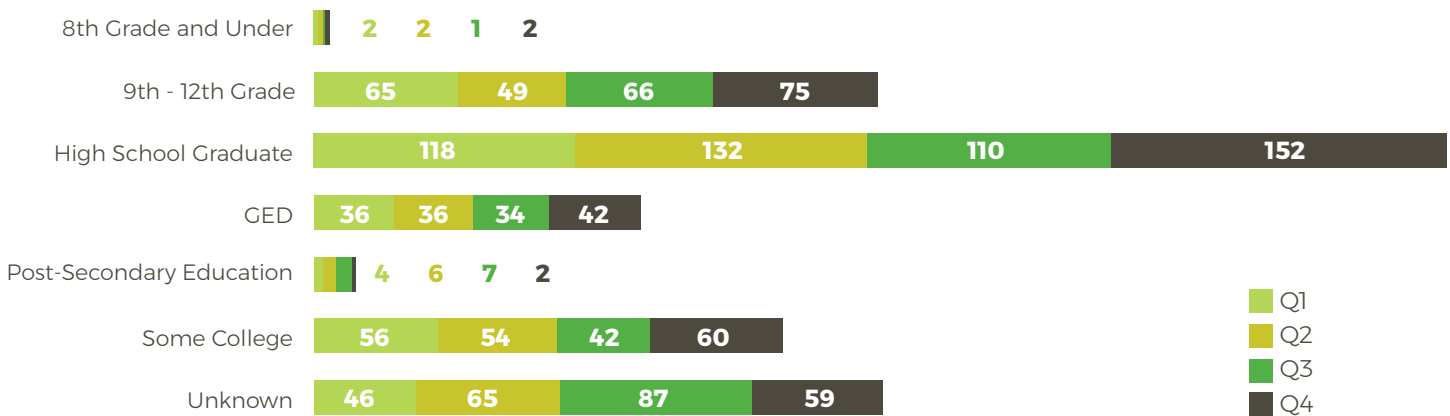
Enrollment

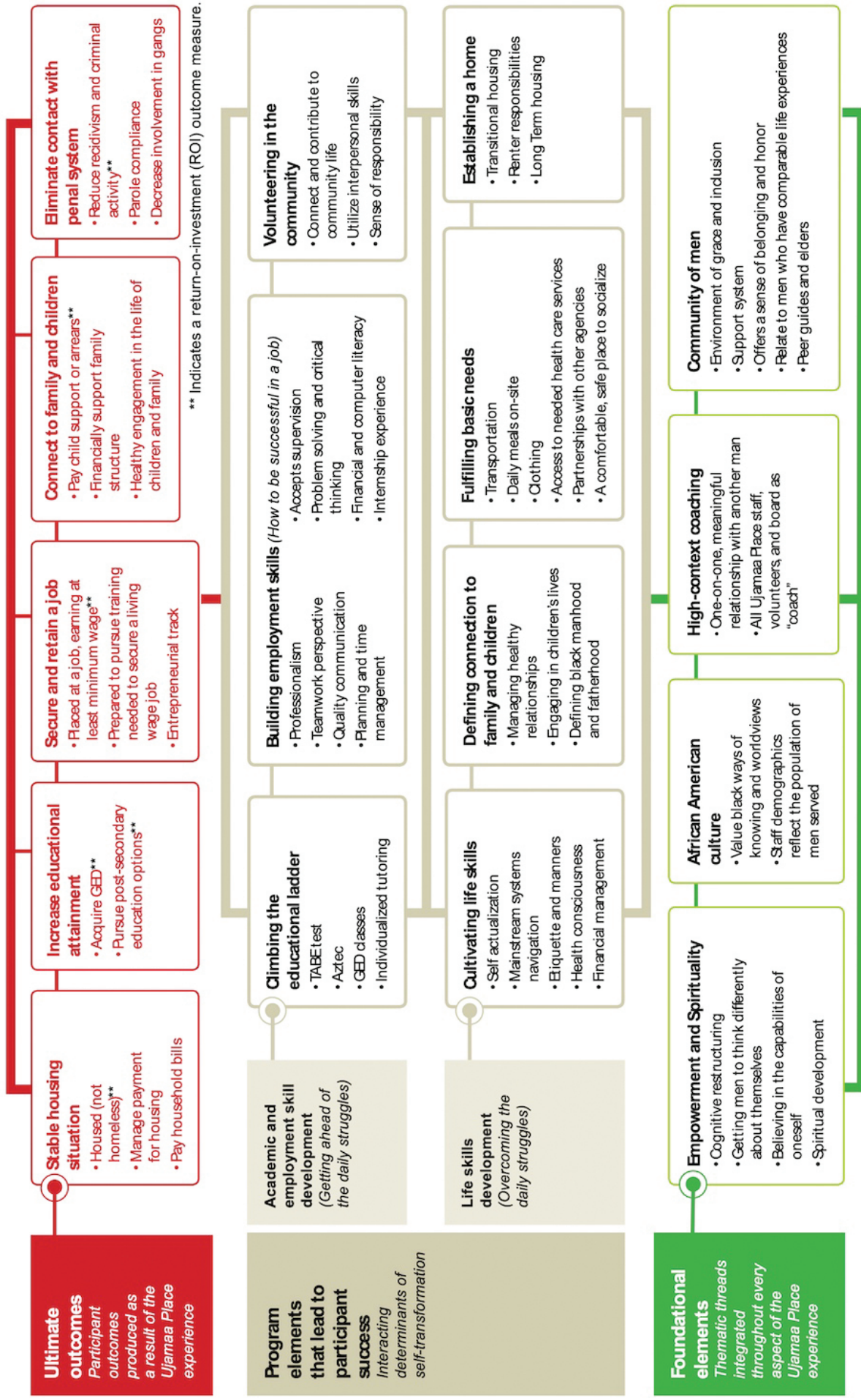
