Expo 2027 Will Help to Better Position the United States on the World Stage:

Over 7.6 million attendees are expected, and the Expo will afford the U.S. and Minnesota a unique PR and positioning opportunity and will support future tourism and business investment.



Expo 2027 Will Promote a Healthy Job Market: Expo 2027 will support of 33,000 jobs in the United States, including 17,000 in Minnesota.



Expo 2027 Will Directly Benefit National and Local Businesses: Nearly 90% of Expo attendance will come from non-resident visitors to the MSP metro area. International visitors will travel to MSP and other U.S. destinations during an average trip of 12 days, spending a total of nearly 3 million days in the United States.



Expo 2027 Will Generate Tax Revenue to Support State, Local & Federal Government: About \$103 per non-resident visitor will be collected in tax receipts, \$50 of which will go to state & local authorities.
