1.6 **APPROPRIATION.**

1.7 \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2024 and \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2025 are appropriated from

1.8 the workforce development fund to the commissioner of employment and economic

1.9 development for a grant to the Minnesota Alliance of Boys and Girls Clubs to administer

1.10 a statewide project of youth job skills and career development. This project, which may

1.11 have career guidance components including health and life skills, must be designed to

- 1.12 encourage, train, and assist youth in early access to education and job-seeking skills,
- 1.13 work-based learning experience, including career pathways in STEM learning, career
- 1.14 exploration and matching, and first job placement through local community partnerships
- 1.15 and on-site job opportunities. This grant requires a 25 percent match from nonstate resources.
