BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

## Section 1. APPROPRIATION; SMALL BUSINESS GROWTH ACCELERATION 1.5 PROGRAM. 1.6

\$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2024 and \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2025 are appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to Enterprise Minnesota, Inc., to directly invest in Minnesota manufacturers for the small business growth acceleration program under Minnesota Statutes, 116O.115. This is a onetime appropriation.

## Sec. 2. APPROPRIATION; ENTERPRISE MINNESOTA, INC.

- (a) \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2024 and \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2025 are appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to Enterprise Minnesota, Inc., to reach and deliver talent, leadership, employee retention, continuous improvement, strategy, quality management systems, revenue growth, and manufacturing peer-to-peer advisory services to small manufacturing companies employing 35 or fewer full-time equivalent employees.
- (b) No later than February 1, 2025, and February 1, 2026, Enterprise Minnesota, Inc., must provide a report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over economic development that includes:
