

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 2331 as follows:

1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. APPROPRIATION; COMMUNITY ACTION PARTNERSHIP OF
1.4 HENNEPIN COUNTY (CAP-HC).

1.5 (a) \$59,000,000 in fiscal year 2024 is appropriated from the general fund to the
1.6 commissioner of employment and economic development for grants to provide economic
1.7 development opportunities and that create economic development within the Black
1.8 community. This is a onetime appropriation and is available until expended.

1.9 (b) Of the amount appropriated in paragraph (a):

1.10 (1) \$9,000,000 is to expand vocational education options and training opportunities that
1.11 prepare participants for meaningful careers and entry into the workforce and to help combat
1.12 poverty and joblessness among Black people in some of Minnesota's poorest communities;

1.13 (2) \$20,000,000 is to create 1,000 nontraditional employment opportunities for
1.14 hard-to-employ Black residents, targeting Black men, that do not have a high school diploma
1.15 or college degree and have a very limited or sporadic work history; and

1.16 (3) \$30,000,000 is to fund a revolving pool of funds geared toward Black business
1.17 development, managed by a tripartite board composed of an equal number of members from
1.18 the community sector, the nonprofit sector, and the elected sector of Black Minnesotans."

1.19 Delete the title and insert:

1.20 "A bill for an act
1.21 relating to economic development; appropriating money for a grant to Community
1.22 Action Partnership of Hennepin County (CAP-HC) to nurture economic
1.23 development in the Black community."
