S.F. No. 259 – Real Property; Recording & Title Modifications

Overview

S.F. 259 makes clarifying and technical changes to various statutes governing real estate transactions, including the Uniform Commercial Code, the Farmer-Lender Mediation Act, and statutes governing dissolution proceedings.

Summary

Sections 1 and 6-8 clarify the name of the Minnesota extension service.

Section 2 makes a technical change.

Section 3 clarifies that the registrar shall deliver certain copies of the certificate of title upon request.

Sections 4 and **5** amend statutes governing dissolution proceedings. **Section 4** requires the court to direct the parties or their counsel to submit a proposed summary real estate disposition judgment if real estate disposition is at issue. **Section 5** provides that the recorder or registrar is not responsible for determining in a summary real estate disposition judgment is court-approved.

Sections 9 and 10 amend the Farmer-Lender Mediation Act by clarifying that the director of the Minnesota Extension Service shall provide mediation request forms upon request.

Section 11 clarifies county recorder duties and provides a minimum retention period.

Section 12 repeals section 346.02 (notice and penalty provision related to unattended animals) and section 582.14 (limitation on foreclosures for mortgages executed prior to 1909).
