**S.F. No. 816 – Maximum Term of Incarceration for a Gross Misdemeanor 364 Days**

**Sections 1 and 2** reduce the maximum sentence for a gross misdemeanor from not more than one year to not more than 364 days. They have an immediate effective date and apply to offenders receiving gross misdemeanor sentences before, on, or after that date.

**Section 3** instructs the revisor of statutes to substitute “364 days” for “one year” consistent with the change in the bill, as well as other technical conforming changes.
