Thank you, Senate Committee members for taking this written testimony. My name is Scott Tiffany and I own a media company. I am against SF70 and abortion rights and what this bill does for those less fortunate and who have no voice.

There would be rioting in the streets if a judge sentenced a person to death without a trial to prove that there was a crime worthy of sentencing. We do not tolerate that in the streets, in our neighborhoods, why would you tolerate that here?

Killing the innocent. That is, in essence, what this bill is allowing in-mass. Sentencing the unborn and those just born to death, without a trial.

Hate evil, love good and maintain justice in the courts. We need to love one another and stand up for injustice and the mistreatment of the weak. If not, where does this end? Does those handicapped or elderly become the next target of those who feel burdened by them living? Is life now becoming just for the luxury of those entitled and in power?

The great Hubert Humphrey in his last public speech said, "The moral test of government is how that government treats those who are in the dawn of life, the children; those who are in the twilight of life, the elderly; and those who are in shadows of life, the sick, the needy, and the handicapped."

Mother Teresa said, "Any country that accepts abortion, is not teaching its people to love but to use violence to get what they want."
