1.3 **S.F. No. 70:** A bill for an act relating to health; repealing certain statutes regulating
 1.4 abortion; repealing certain sex offenses; repealing certain statutes governing the sale of
 1.5 certain articles and information and prohibiting certain advertisements; removing a limitation
 1.6 on the performance of abortions at birth centers; striking certain language regarding medical
 1.7 assistance coverage of abortion; removing a limitation on MinnesotaCare coverage of
 1.8 abortion; making conforming changes; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections 13.3805,
 1.9 subdivision 1; 144.222, subdivision 1; 144.615, subdivision 7; 145.411, subdivisions 1, 5;
 1.10 145.4235, subdivision 2; 148.261, subdivision 1; 256B.0625, subdivision 16; 256B.692,
 1.11 subdivision 2; 256L.03, subdivision 1; 518A.39, subdivision 2; 609.269; 617.22; 617.26;

1.19 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.20 Page 4, line 17, reinstate the stricken comma

1.21 Page 4, line 18, before the semicolon, insert "as determined by the commissioner"

1.22 Page 9, line 8, before the period, insert "determined to be medically necessary by the
 1.23 treating provider and delivered in accordance with all applicable Minnesota laws"

1.24 Page 15, delete section 12 and insert:

1.25 "Sec. 12. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 609.269, is amended to read:

1.26 **609.269 EXCEPTION.**

1.27 Sections 609.2661 to 609.268 do not apply to ~~any act described in section 145.412.~~ a
 1.28 person providing reproductive health care offered, arranged, or furnished:

1.29 (1) for the purpose of terminating a pregnancy; and

1.30 (2) with the consent of the pregnant individual or the pregnant individual's representative,
 1.31 except in a medical emergency in which consent cannot be obtained.

1.32 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment."


1.33 Page 16, delete line 14 and insert:

1.34 "(b) Minnesota Rules, parts 4615.3600; and 9505.0235, are repealed."

1.35 Amend the title numbers accordingly

1.36 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on Finance.
