

1.1 **Senator Latz from the Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety, to which was**
1.2 **referred**

1.3 **S.F. No. 1138:** A bill for an act relating to consumer data protection; requiring
1.4 direct-to-consumer genetic testing companies to provide disclosure notices and obtain
1.5 consent; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 325F.

1.6 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.7 Page 3, line 31, delete "require valid legal process to" insert "not"


1.8 Page 3, line 32, after "consent" insert "unless the disclosure is made pursuant to a valid
1.9 search warrant or court order"

1.10 Page 4, line 11, before "The" insert "(a)"

1.11 Page 4, after line 12, insert:

1.12 "(b) This section does not supersede the requirements and rights described in section
1.13 13.386, or the remedies available under Chapter 13 for violations of section 13.386."

1.14 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on Commerce
1.15 and Consumer Protection. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
