


1.1 **Senator Latz from the Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety, to which was**
1.2 **referred**

1.3 **S.F. No. 294:** A bill for an act relating to public safety; establishing the crime of
1.4 surreptitious intrusion that does not take place through a window or aperture; establishing
1.5 the crime of surreptitious intrusion under or around a person's clothing; amending the statute
1.6 of limitations for the crime of surreptitious intrusion; making technical and conforming
1.7 changes; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections 243.166, subdivision 1b; 609.746,
1.8 subdivision 1; 609A.02, subdivision 3; 628.26.

1.9 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.10 Page 10, line 19, after "date" insert "and to crimes committed before that date if the
1.11 limitations period for the crime did not expire before August 1, 2023"

1.12 And when so amended the bill do pass. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
