S.F. No. 427 – Peace Officer Misconduct Data

Section 1 directs local government officials to cooperate with the POST Board when provided notice that the board is investigating a peace officer. Local officials must provide the board with public, private, and confidential data related to the peace officer who is the subject of the board's investigation. Requires local officials to notify the board when a peace officer was discharged for misconduct.

Section 2 grants immunity from civil and criminal penalties under the data practices act for local officials who comply with the data sharing and notice requirements in section 1, unless the information is false and presented with the intention of causing reputational harm to the peace officer.
