1.3 "Sec. 4. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 517.04, is amended to read:

1.4 **517.04 PERSONS AUTHORIZED TO PERFORM CIVIL MARRIAGES.**

1.5 Civil marriages may be solemnized throughout the state by an individual who has attained  
1.6 the age of 21 years and is a judge of a court of record, a retired judge of a court of record,  
1.7 a court administrator, a retired court administrator with the approval of the chief judge of  
1.8 the judicial district, a former court commissioner who is employed by the court system or  
1.9 is acting pursuant to an order of the chief judge of the commissioner's judicial district, a  
1.10 notary public authorized by the secretary of state, the residential school superintendent of  
1.11 the Minnesota State Academy for the Deaf and the Minnesota State Academy for the Blind,  
1.12 a licensed or ordained minister of any religious denomination, an individual who registers  
1.13 as a civil marriage officiant with a local registrar in a county of this state, or by any mode  
1.14 recognized in section 517.18. For purposes of this section, a court of record includes the  
1.15 Office of Administrative Hearings under section 14.48."
