S.F. No. 1446 – Questioned Identity Process

S.F. No. 1446 provides a review process to be used by the BCA for persons who believe their identities are being used by an offender in interactions with law enforcement or where an offender has the same name as the person, and this has led to difficulties in distinguishing the two. Specifies the information that must be provided by the person to facilitate the review. If the BCA confirms that the person is the subject of a questioned identity, the agency must provide documentation to the person confirming this. Requires law enforcement to take the questioned identity into account when considering whether the person has a warrant under Minnesota Statutes, section 299C.115 (warrant information provided to the state).
