

1.1 **Senator Latz from the Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety, to which was**
1.2 **referred**

1.3 **S.F. No. 225:** A bill for an act relating to building codes; modifying carbon monoxide
1.4 alarm requirements for hotels and lodging houses; requiring a safety warning for violation;
1.5 amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections 299F.50, by adding subdivisions; 299F.51,
1.6 subdivisions 1, 2, 5, by adding a subdivision.

1.7 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.8 Page 1, after line 6, insert:

1.9 "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 299F.46, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.10 Subdivision 1. **Hotel inspection.** (a) It shall be the duty of the commissioner of public
1.11 safety to inspect, or cause to be inspected, at least once every three years, every hotel in
1.12 this state; and, for that purpose, the commissioner, or the commissioner's deputies or
1.13 designated alternates or agents, shall have the right to enter or have access thereto at any
1.14 reasonable hour; and, when, upon such inspection, it shall be found that the hotel so inspected
1.15 does not conform to or is not being operated in accordance with the provisions of sections
1.16 157.011 and 157.15 to 157.22, in so far as the same relate to fire prevention or fire protection
1.17 of hotels, or the rules promulgated thereunder, or is being maintained or operated in such
1.18 manner as to violate the Minnesota State Fire Code promulgated pursuant to section 326B.02,
1.19 subdivision 6, 299F.51, or any other law of this state relating to fire prevention and fire
1.20 protection of hotels, the commissioner and the deputies or designated alternates or agents
1.21 shall report such a situation to the hotel inspector who shall proceed as provided for in
1.22 chapter 157.

1.23 (b) The word "hotel", as used in this subdivision, has the meaning given in section
1.24 299F.391."

1.25 Renumber the sections in sequence

1.26 Amend the title numbers accordingly

1.27 And when so amended the bill do pass. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
