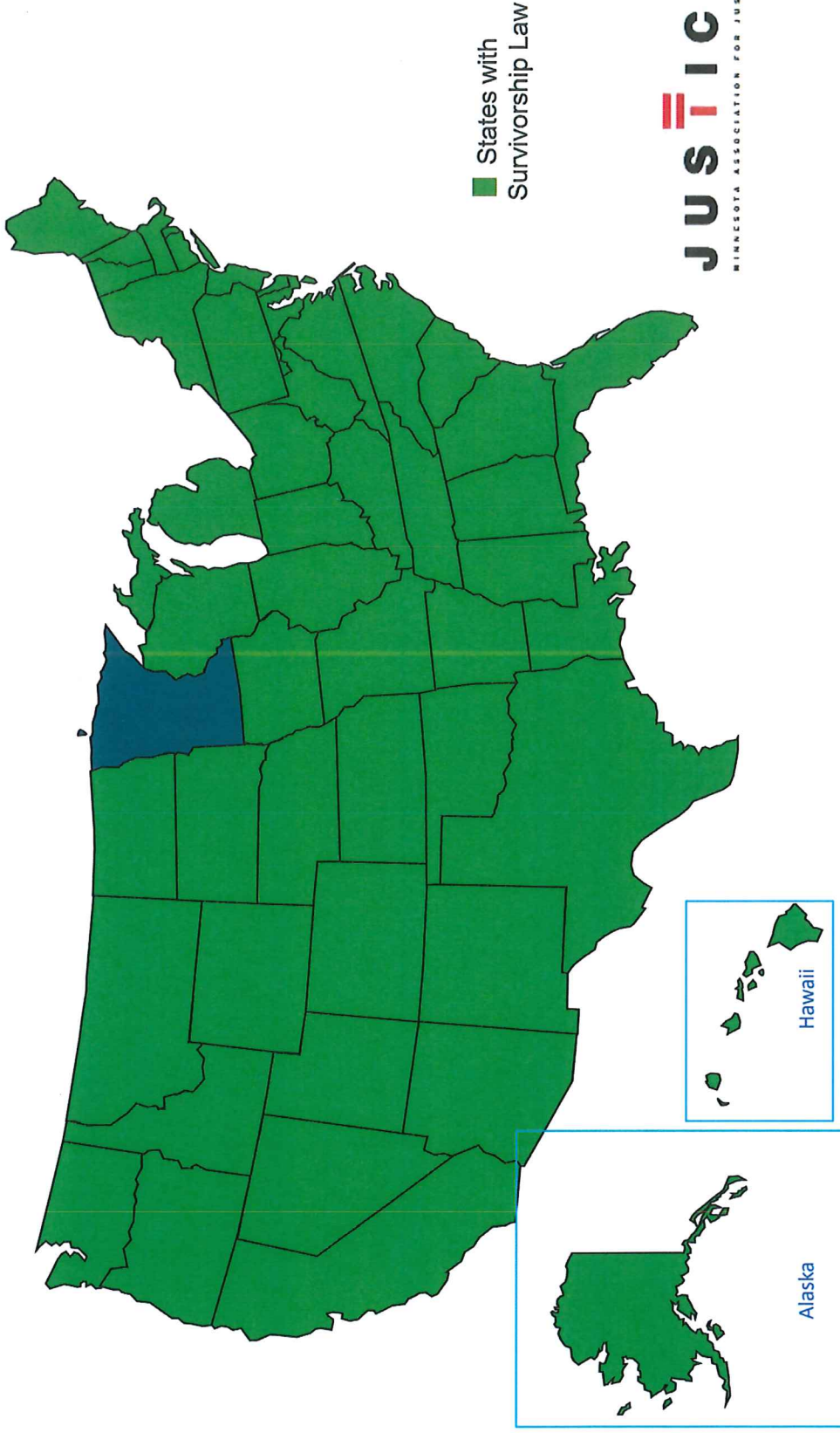

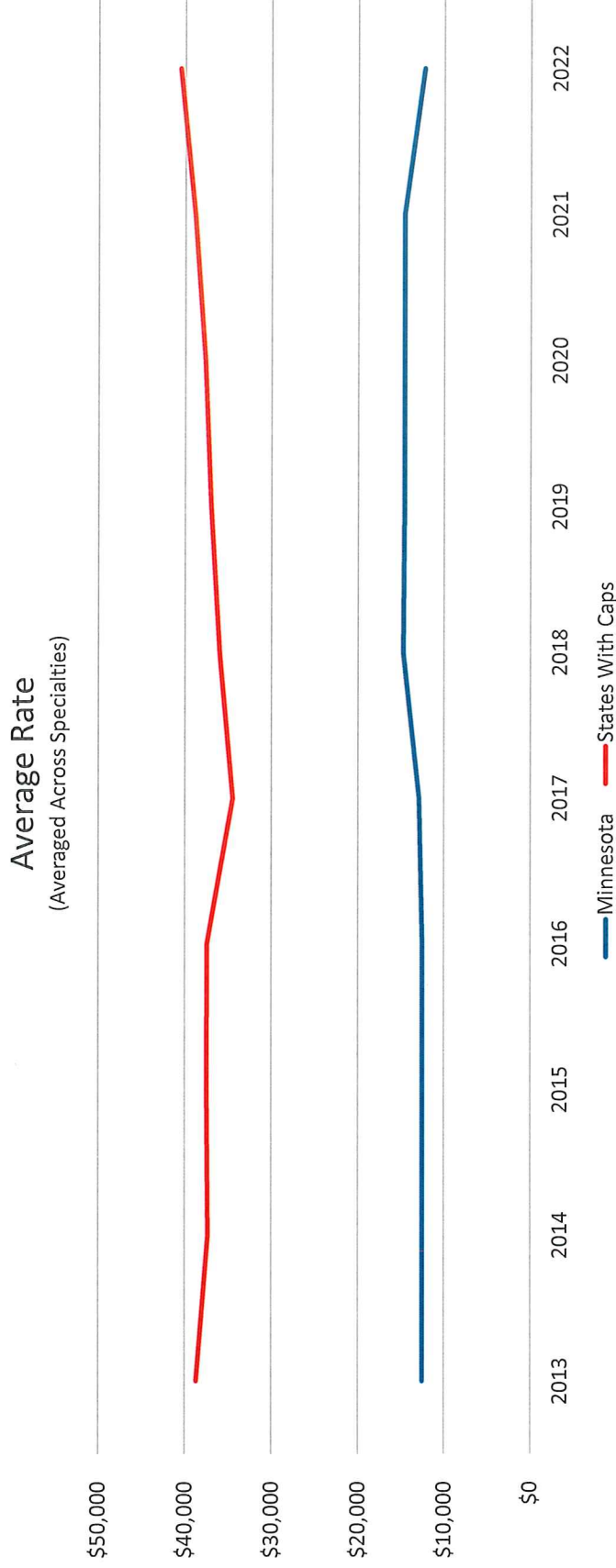

# How Do Rates in Minnesota Compare to States With Caps?



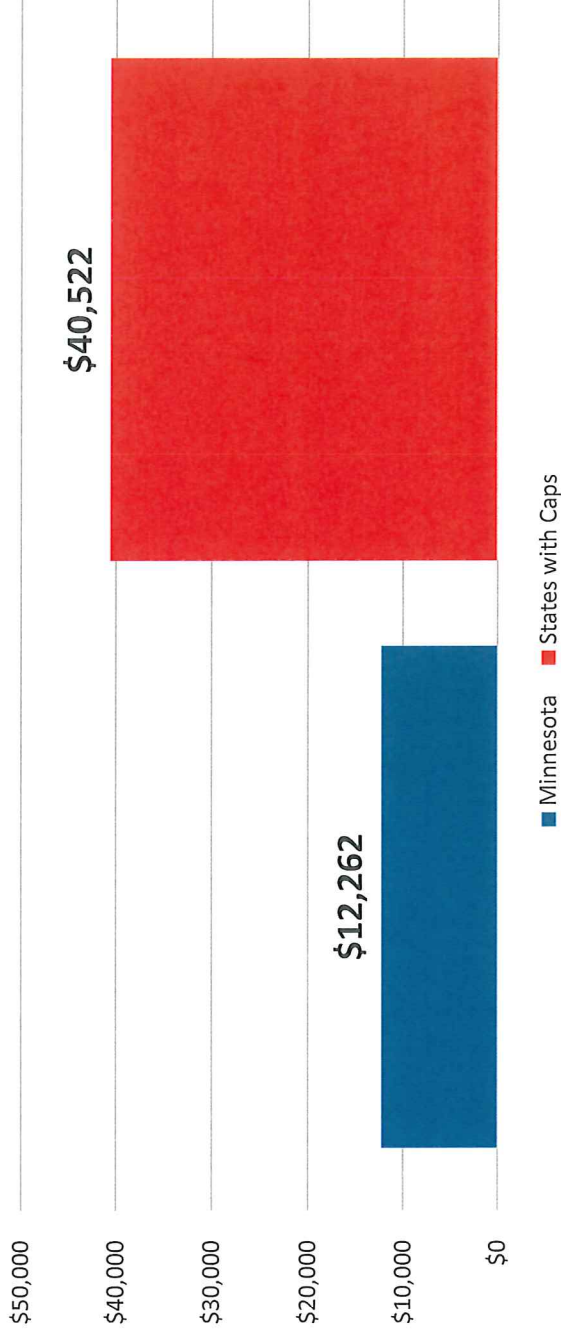
Medical malpractice insurance rates for doctors averaged across specialties have consistently been the lowest in the country and are significantly lower than the average rates in states with caps.
