Sections 1 to 18 strike the term “reparations” and inserts “reimbursement” throughout sections 611A.51 to 611A.68, formerly known as the Minnesota Crime Victims Reparations Act.

In addition, **section 5** of the bill clarifies how “cooperation” with law enforcement will be determined for the purposes of limitations on awards; and **section 6** states that “contributory misconduct” does not include current or past affiliation with any particular group.

Finally, **section 19** of the bill contains instructions to the revisor to change “reparations” and “reparable” to “reimbursement” and “reimbursable” where applicable in Minnesota Statutes.
