The bill appropriates \$500,000 in fiscal year 2024 and \$500,000 in fiscal year 2025 from the general fund to the commissioner of public safety for reimbursements to local units of government that operate pathway to policing programs. Applicants may receive up to 50 percent of the cost of compensating and training program participants. Reimbursement grants shall be proportionally allocated based on the number of grant applications approved by the commissioner.
