1.2 Page 1, after line 5, insert:

1.3 "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 169A.41, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.4 Subdivision 1. **When authorized.** When a peace officer has reason to believe from the

1.5 manner in which a person is driving, operating, controlling, or acting upon departure from

1.6 a motor vehicle, or has driven, operated, or controlled a motor vehicle, that the driver may

1.7 be violating or has violated section 169A.20 (driving while impaired), 169A.31

1.8 (alcohol-related school bus or Head Start bus driving), ~~or~~ 169A.33 (underage drinking and

1.9 driving), 221.0314 (alcohol-related commercial driving), or 221.605 (alcohol-related

1.10 commercial driving), the officer may require the driver to provide a sample of the driver's

1.11 breath for a preliminary screening test using a device approved by the commissioner for

1.12 this purpose."

1.13 Renumber the sections in sequence and correct the internal references

1.14 Amend the title accordingly
