- 1.15 Page 3, line 3, delete the new language and strike the old language
- 1.16 Page 3, line 4, strike everything before the period and insert "<u>builder's risk policies</u>,
- 1.17 owner or contractor-controlled insurance programs or policies, or project-specific insurance
- 1.18 for claims arising out of the promisor's negligent acts or omissions or the negligent acts or
- 1.19 omissions of the promisor's, independent contractors, agents, employees, or delegatees"
- 1.20 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on Finance.
- 1.21 Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
