1.3 **S.F. No. 1507:** A bill for an act relating to elections; prohibiting intimidation of election
1.4 officials; prohibiting interference with the performance of a duty of election administration
1.5 by an election official; prohibiting tampering with or unauthorized access to certain types
1.6 of election systems and equipment; providing penalties; appropriating money; amending
1.7 Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections 8.31, subdivision 1; 204B.26; 206.845, subdivision 1;
1.8 211B.32, subdivision 1; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 211B.

1.9 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.10 Page 3, line 8, delete "may show" and insert "must demonstrate"

1.11 Page 4, line 31, delete everything after "section"

1.12 Page 4, line 32, delete everything before the period

1.13 Page 5, line 12, delete "the day following final enactment" and insert "June 15, 2023"

1.14 Page 5, line 13, delete "crimes committed" and insert "violations occurring"

1.15 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on State and
1.16 Local Government and Veterans. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
