1.6 subdivision 8; 144.218, subdivisions 1, 2; 144.225, subdivision 2; 144.2252; 259.83,
1.7 subdivisions 1, 1a, 1b, by adding a subdivision; 260C.317, subdivision 4; proposing coding
1.8 for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 144; repealing Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections
1.9 144.212, subdivision 11; 259.83, subdivision 3; 259.89; 260C.637.

1.10 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.11 Page 4, line 19, delete "subdivision 2,"

1.12 Page 4, line 21, delete "certified"

1.13 Page 5, line 21, delete "2022" and insert "2024"

1.14 Page 7, line 9, after the semicolon, insert "and"

1.15 Page 7, line 10, delete "; and" and insert a period


1.16 Page 7, delete line 11

1.17 Page 8, line 15, after "(a)" insert "Except as provided in paragraph (b),"

1.18 Page 8, delete lines 16 and 17 and insert:

1.19 "(b) Sections 7 and 14 are effective August 1, 2023."

1.20 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on Health
1.21 and Human Services. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
