1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to transportation; requiring a minimum crew size for certain rail carriers;

1.3 imposing penalties; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. [219.752] MINIMUM CREW SIZE.

1.7 (a) A Class I railroad or Class II railroad must not operate a train or light engine used

1.8 in connection with the movement of freight unless it has a crew of a minimum of two

1.9 individuals. This section does not apply to hostler services or utility employees.

1.10 (b) Any railroad that willfully violates this section must pay a fine of not less than \$250

1.11 or more than \$1,000 for a first offense, not less than \$1,000 or more than \$5,000 for a second

1.12 offense committed within three years of the first offense, and not less than \$5,000 nor more

1.13 than \$10,000 for a third or subsequent offense committed within three years of the first

1.14 offense.

1.15 (c) Fines prescribed in this section must be recovered in a civil action before a judge of

1.16 the county in which the violation occurs.

1.17 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective 30 days following final enactment.
