**S.F. No. 2495** provides that admissions, confessions, or statements made by a person in a custodial setting are considered involuntarily made and inadmissible if the interrogator knowingly communicated false facts about evidence, misrepresented the accuracy of facts, or communicated unauthorized statements regarding leniency.
