1.9	injury. Whoever violates subdivision 2, clause (2), is guilty of a felony and may be sentenced

1.11 1.12 1.13	(1) to imprisonment for not more than ten years or to payment of a fine of not more than \$20,000, or both, if the call triggers an emergency response and, as a result of the response, someone suffers great bodily harm or death . ; or

1.15	than \$10,000, or both, if the call triggers an emergency response and as a result of the
1.16	response, someone suffers substantial bodily harm.
