S.F. 1657 classifies tax returns and bank account statements as private or nonpublic data when they are submitted to a political subdivision by a person seeking to obtain a license. This bill requires political subdivisions to destroy tax return and bank account statement data no later than 90 days after a final decision on the license application.

Effective date. This bill is effective the day following final enactment and data collected prior to the effective date must be destroyed no later than 90 days following final enactment.
