## 1.13 **REQUIRED.**

- Subdivision 1. Review. (a) The commissioner of public safety shall conduct a review 1.14
- of the statutes and the department's administrative rules and policies governing the process 1.15
- by which a person's driving privileges are reinstated, in whole or in part, following a driving 1.16
- 1.17 while impaired incident.
- (b) At a minimum, the review must focus on: 1.18
- 1.19 (1) identifying requirements that needlessly impede a person's ability to reacquire driving
- privileges, such as requiring documents or other items from sufficiently far in the past that 1.20
- would prove unduly cumbersome or impossible for the average person to procure; and 1.21
- (2) analyzing the feasibility of a process and identifying criteria by which the 1.22
- commissioner may waive requirements for reinstatement in particular cases. 1.23
- Subd. 2. Report. By February 15, 2024, the commissioner shall report to the chairs and 1.24
- ranking minority members of the legislative committees on public safety and transportation 1.25
- on the review conducted under subdivision 1, including any recommended changes to statute, 1.26
