

1.1 **Senator Latz from the Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety, to which was**
1.2 **re-referred**

1.3 **S.F. No. 1336:** A bill for an act relating to public safety; making various policy changes,
1.4 including to veterans' license plates, dealer licenses and records, USDOT numbers, and
1.5 driver's license applications; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections 168.1235,
1.6 subdivision 1; 168.1253, subdivision 3; 168.185; 168.27, subdivisions 11, 16; 168A.11,
1.7 subdivision 3; 169A.60, subdivision 13; 171.06, subdivision 3, by adding a subdivision;
1.8 171.0605, subdivisions 3, 5; 171.12, by adding a subdivision; repealing Minnesota Statutes
1.9 2022, sections 168.345, subdivision 1; 171.06, subdivision 3a.

1.10 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.11 Page 12, after line 16, insert:

1.12 "Sec. 13. **DWI DRIVING PRIVILEGE REINSTATEMENT REVIEW; REPORT**
1.13 **REQUIRED.**

1.14 Subdivision 1. **Review.** (a) The commissioner of public safety shall conduct a review
1.15 of the statutes and the department's administrative rules and policies governing the process
1.16 by which a person's driving privileges are reinstated, in whole or in part, following a driving
1.17 while impaired incident.

1.18 (b) At a minimum, the review must focus on:

1.19 (1) identifying requirements that needlessly impede a person's ability to reacquire driving
1.20 privileges, such as requiring documents or other items from sufficiently far in the past that
1.21 would prove unduly cumbersome or impossible for the average person to procure; and

1.22 (2) analyzing the feasibility of a process and identifying criteria by which the
1.23 commissioner may waive requirements for reinstatement in particular cases.


1.24 Subd. 2. **Report.** By February 15, 2024, the commissioner shall report to the chairs and
1.25 ranking minority members of the legislative committees on public safety and transportation
1.26 on the review conducted under subdivision 1, including any recommended changes to statute,
1.27 rule, or policy identified by it."

1.28 Renumber the sections in sequence

1.29 Amend the title as follows:

1.30 Page 1, line 4, after "applications;" insert "requiring a report;"

1.31 And when so amended the bill do pass. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
