## S.F. No. 1368 – Commercial energy code adoption modifications (A-2)

**Date:** March 2, 2023

**S.F. 1368** directs the commissioner of labor and industry, beginning in 2024, to adopt each new published edition of the model commercial energy code ASHRAE 90.1 or a more efficient standard. Requires adopting commercial energy codes incrementally so that by 2036 the code achieves a minimum 80 percent reduction in annual net energy consumption compared to a baseline. Requires the commissioner to make a report to the legislature on progress towards that goal by January 15 of the year following each new code adoption. Specifies that the ability of a public utility offer code support programs or claim energy savings through conservation and optimization plans are not affected by these changes.
