Bill Description

Section 1 creates the employer-sponsored meetings or communication statute.

Subdivision 1 prohibits an employer from taking adverse employment action against an employee: (1) for declining to participate in an employer-sponsored meeting or receive employer communications about the employer's religious or political opinions; (2) as a means to induce the employee to participate in an employer-sponsored meeting or receive employer communications about the employer's religious or political opinions; or (3) because the employee makes a good faith report of the adverse employment action.

Subdivision 2 provides that an employee aggrieved by a violation of subdivision 1 can file a civil action within 90 days of the alleged violation in district court and can seek injunctive relief, reinstatement, backpay, and other remedies, as well as attorney fees and costs.

Subdivision 3 requires employers to post a notice of employee rights under the employer-sponsored meetings or communication statute.

Subdivision 4 establishes the employer-sponsored meetings or communication statute does not: (1) prohibit communications an employer is required to communicate; (2) limit an employer's rights to conduct meetings or provide communications regarding religious or political matters as long as participation or receipt is voluntary; or (3) limit an employer from communicating information necessary for employees to perform their jobs.

Subdivision 5 defines political matters and religious matters.

This bill is effective the day following final enactment.

Assumptions

DLI assumes it does not have authority to enforce this statute because subdivision 2 specifies that aggrieved employees have the right to pursue a civil action for violations of the statute. As DLI does not have enforcement authority, the bill has no fiscal impact on the Department.

If inquiries are received related to this bill, DLI would guide inquirers to the new law and provide referral information for private attorneys. These inquiries would be immaterial and handled by existing staff.

Bill Description

HF2442-0 creates new law prohibiting an employer from forcing employees to attend political or religious meetings or otherwise listen to speech about politics and religion. This bill provides an employee the right to bring a civil action for injunctive relief or other remedies if an employer violates the provisions in this bill. This bill requires an employer subject to this section to post a notice of employees' rights.

Assumptions

It is assumed this bill may impact case filings by an employee against an employer in violation of this legislation.
