


1.1 **Senator Dzedzic from the Committee on Rules and Administration, to which was**  
1.2 **referred under Joint Rule 2.03, together with the committee report thereon,**

1.3 **S.F. No. 49:** A bill for an act relating to human services; establishing transitional  
1.4 cost-sharing reduction, premium subsidy, small employer public option, and transitional  
1.5 health care credit; expanding eligibility for MinnesotaCare; modifying premium scale;  
1.6 requiring recommendations for alternative delivery and payment system; amending Minnesota  
1.7 Statutes 2022, sections 62V.05, by adding a subdivision; 256L.04, subdivisions 1c, 7a, 10,  
1.8 by adding a subdivision; 256L.07, subdivision 1; 256L.15, subdivision 2; 290.06, by adding  
1.9 a subdivision.

1.10 Reports the same back with the recommendation that Joint Rule 2.03 be suspended for  
1.11 all further proceedings on S.F. No. 49 and that the report from the Committee on Health  
1.12 and Human Services, shown in the Journal for April 3, 2023, be amended to read:

1.13 "the bill be amended and when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the  
1.14 Committee on Commerce and Consumer Protection". Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
