


1.1 **Senator Dzedzic from the Committee on Rules and Administration, to which was**
1.2 **referred under Joint Rule 2.03, together with the committee report thereon,**

1.3 **S.F. No. 200:** A bill for an act relating to judiciary; eliminating the fee for uncertified
1.4 copies of instruments from civil or criminal proceedings; providing expedited attorney entry
1.5 to district courthouse buildings; providing attorneys secured access to court records;
1.6 amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 357.021, subdivision 2; proposing coding for
1.7 new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 484.

1.8 Reports the same back with the recommendation that Joint Rule 2.03 be suspended for
1.9 all further proceedings on S.F. No. 200 and that the report from the Committee on Judiciary
1.10 and Public Safety, shown in the Journal for April 25, 2023, be adopted; that committee
1.11 recommendation being:

1.12 "the bill be amended and when so amended the bill do pass". Amendments adopted.
1.13 Report adopted.
