


1.1 **Senator Dziedzic from the Committee on Rules and Administration, to which was**
1.2 **referred under Joint Rule 2.03, together with the committee report thereon,**

1.3 **H.F. No. 2950:** A bill for an act relating to retirement; making administrative changes
1.4 to the statutes governing the retirement plans administered by the Minnesota State Retirement
1.5 System, the Public Employees Retirement Association, and the Teachers Retirement
1.6 Association; amending eligibility to permit appointed local government officials to participate
1.7 in the public employees defined contribution plan; permitting the transfer of service credit
1.8 from the general public employees retirement plan to the public employees police and fire
1.9 retirement plan for two employees of the Metropolitan Airports Commission; permitting
1.10 eligible retired teachers in the St. Paul Teachers Retirement Fund Association to change
1.11 the teacher's retirement annuity to an annuity that will pay a survivor annuity to a same-sex
1.12 spouse; authorizing certain members of the higher education individual retirement account
1.13 plan to elect Teachers Retirement Association coverage and receive retroactive service
1.14 credit; extending the payment period for the purchase of service credit for periods of military
1.15 service; increasing the cap on the employer contribution to certain trades' multiemployer
1.16 pension plans; Public Employees Retirement Association statewide volunteer firefighter
1.17 plan; modifying service counted in determining vesting in a retirement benefit, amending
1.18 requirements applicable to a relief association after the affiliated fire department joins the
1.19 statewide plan, and authorizing the Hamel and Loretto volunteer firefighter relief associations
1.20 to join the statewide plan mid-year and merge; increasing the dollar threshold for requiring
1.21 audited financial reports for volunteer firefighter relief associations; amending Minnesota
1.22 Statutes 2022, sections 352B.08, subdivision 1; 353.01, subdivisions 2a, 2b, 15; 353.0162;
1.23 353.031, subdivision 10; 353.32, subdivision 1c; 353D.01, subdivision 2, by adding a
1.24 subdivision; 353D.02, subdivision 1; 353D.03, subdivision 1; 353E.001, by adding
1.25 subdivisions; 353E.07, subdivisions 3, 4, 5; 353G.01, subdivisions 8, 15, by adding
1.26 subdivisions; 353G.06, subdivisions 2, 3; 353G.09, subdivisions 1, 2, by adding a subdivision;
1.27 353G.14; 354.06, subdivision 2; 354.53, subdivision 3; 354A.093, subdivision 4; 356.24,
1.28 subdivision 1; 356.551, subdivision 2; 424A.014, subdivision 1; 490.1211; proposing coding
1.29 for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 354A; repealing Minnesota Statutes 2022,
1.30 sections 353.01, subdivision 15a; 353G.01, subdivision 7; 353G.13; 490.124, subdivision
1.31 10.

1.32 Reports the same back with the recommendation that Joint Rule 2.03 be suspended for
1.33 all further proceedings on H.F. No. 2950 and that the report from the Committee on State
1.34 and Local Government and Veterans, shown in the Journal for May 4, 2023, be adopted;
1.35 that committee recommendation being:
