

1.1 A Committee resolution
1.2 relating to the Senate contribution to the employee deferred compensation program.
1.3 BE IT RESOLVED, by the Committee on Rules and Administration:
1.4 1. Regular Senate employees may elect to receive an employer-paid contribution to the state
1.5 deferred compensation program, or elect to convert vacation or compensatory time to deferred
1.6 compensation as provided in Section 2, paragraphs A and B of the Pre-Tax Accounts, Deferred
1.7 Compensation and Health Care Savings Plan chapter of the Legislative Coordinating Commission
1.8 Legislative Plan for Employee Benefits and Policies and as provided in this resolution.
1.9 2. Beginning July 1, 2023, until June 30, 2024, regular employees of the Senate may elect
1.10 to convert up to a total of 50 hours of compensatory time earned in the 2023 regular legislative
1.11 session or vacation time to deferred compensation or may elect to receive an employer-paid matching
1.12 contribution up to \$1,150.
