S.F. No. 2182 – Expansion of sales tax exemption for baby products

Under current law, breast pumps, baby bottles and nipples, pacifiers, teething rings, and infant syringes are exempt from sales tax. This bill adds baby wipes, cribs and bassinets, crib and bassinet mattresses, crib and bassinet sheets, changing tables, changing pads, strollers, car seats and car seat bases, baby swings, bottle sterilizers, and infant eating utensils to the exemption.

Effective for sales and purchases made after June 30, 2023.
