Department of Revenue Analysis of H.F. 1847 (Howard) / S.F. 2065 (Wiklund)

The bill authorizes, if approved by the voters at a general election, the city of Richfield to impose a sales and use tax of 0.5%.

The proceeds would be used to finance \$11 million for Wood Lake Nature Center building, \$9 million for Veterans Park Complex and \$45 million for Richfield Community Center Project. The bill authorizes a bond issuance of up to \$65 million plus bond costs.

The tax would terminate at the earlier of 20 years from when first imposed or when the city council determines that sufficient funds have been received from the tax to pay for the costs of the projects listed above. The tax could expire earlier if the city so determines by ordinance.

The bill would have no impact on state taxes.
