

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 1776 as follows:

1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. Laws 2019, First Special Session chapter 6, article 7, section 7, is amended

1.5 **Sec. 7. CITY OF DULUTH; TAX INCREMENT FINANCING DISTRICT; SPECIAL**
1.6 **RULES AUTHORIZATION.**

1.7 Subdivision 1. **Establishment.** The city of Duluth or the Duluth Economic Development
1.8 Authority may establish, by resolution, one or more redevelopment tax increment financing
1.9 ~~district~~ districts located in the city of Duluth, St. Louis County, Minnesota, within the area
1.10 bordered on the northeast by Slip 3 and the Pier B Resort property line extended northwest
1.11 to Interstate 35, on the southeast by the Duluth Harbor, on the southwest by the Compass
1.12 Minerals property line extended northwest to Interstate 35, and on the northwest by Interstate
1.13 35, together with adjacent roads and rights-of-way; and such property is deemed to meet
1.14 the requirements of Minnesota Statutes, section 469.174, subdivision 10.

1.15 Subd. 2. **Eligible expenditures.** Expenditures incurred in connection with the
1.16 development of the property described in subdivision 1 are deemed to meet the requirements
1.17 of Minnesota Statutes, section 469.176, subdivision 4j. Eligible expenditures for any tax
1.18 increment financing district established in the area described in subdivision 1 include,
1.19 without limitation, seawalls and pier facings adjacent to the boundaries of such district.

1.20 Subd. 3. **Duration.** Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 469.176, subdivision
1.21 1b, or any other law to the contrary, the city of Duluth or its economic development authority
1.22 may extend the duration limit of a district established under subdivision 1 by ten years.

1.23 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** (a) The change to subdivision 1 is effective the day after the
1.24 governing body of the city of Duluth and its chief clerical officer comply with Minnesota
1.25 Statutes, section 645.021, subdivisions 2 and 3.

1.26 (b) Subdivision 3 is effective upon compliance by the city of Duluth, St. Louis County,
1.27 and Independent School District No. 709 with the requirements of Minnesota Statutes,
1.28 section 469.1782, subdivision 2."
