

S.F. No. 2920 – City of Windom; Providing Supplemental Aid to Windom School District; Appropriating Funds to City of Windom (as proposed to be amended by A-1 delete-everything amendment)

Section 1. Appropriations; city of Windom. Appropriates \$13 million in fiscal year 2023 from the general fund to the commissioner of revenue for a grant to the city of Windom. This is a onetime appropriation and is available until June 30, 2025. The grant must be allocated as follows:

1. \$10 million must be used by the city to facilitate the completion of the Windom HyLife Affordable Housing Development;
2. \$2 million must be used by the city for repayment of loans issued to the city from the Public Facilities Authority for wastewater improvements related to the Hylife Foods Windom processing plant; and
3. \$1 million must be used by the city for recruitment efforts relating to locating and securing a purchaser for the Hylife Foods Windom processing plant.

The \$10 million and \$2 million appropriations are contingent upon certification from the city of Windom that HyLife Foods has not entered into a contract to transfer ownership of the HyLife Foods Windom processing plant. Certification must be made on or before July 1, 2023.

Section 2. Appropriation; Windom School District. Appropriates \$1 million from the general fund to the Department of Education in fiscal year 2024 only for onetime supplemental aid to Windom School District. The aid amount equals \$10,000 times the difference between the October 1, 2022 pupil enrollment count and the October 1, 2023 pupil enrollment count. Effective the day following final enactment.
