### Request: \$3 million (GF)

- Provide flexible parking options for hybrid teleworking employees and visitors
- Install modern parking access controls at state-owned parking facilities
- Data driven operations will increase efficiency and minimize parking space vacancies



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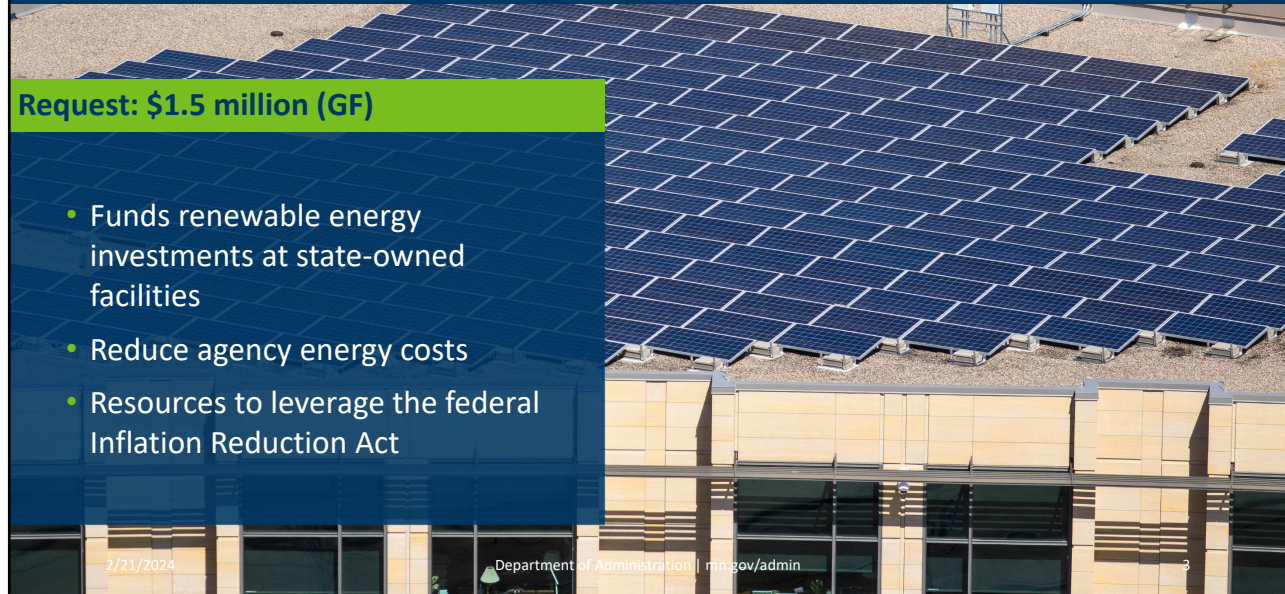
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## State Facility Renewable Energy and Storage Fund

**Request: \$1.5 million (GF)**

- Funds renewable energy investments at state-owned facilities
- Reduce agency energy costs
- Resources to leverage the federal Inflation Reduction Act



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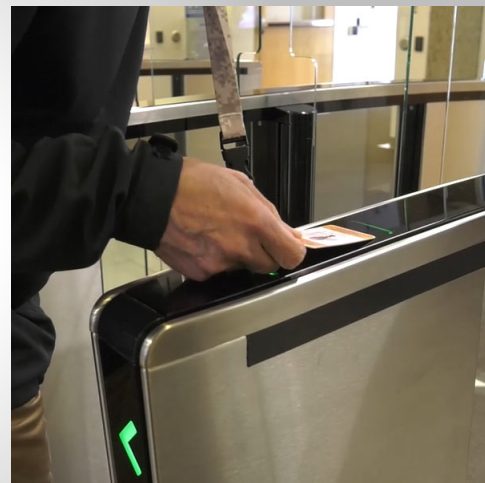
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## Capitol Complex Security Upgrades Phase III

**Request: \$4 million (GO), \$1.8 million (TH)**

- Make upgrades recommended by the Advisory Committee on Capitol Area Security in 2014
- Updated security assessment in 2022
- Work on the Transportation Building cannot be funded by general obligation bonds
- Majority of the Capitol Complex is still without security upgrades



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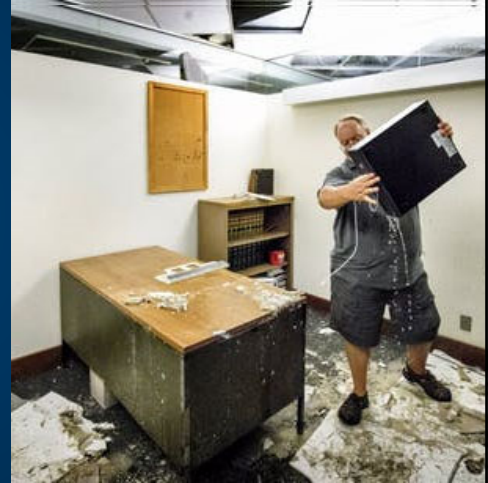


## Capital Asset Preservation and Replacement Account
