1.1A bill for an act

1.2relating to consumer protection; prohibiting the possession, manufacture, or sale

1.3of cellular telephone cases resembling a firearm; providing a civil penalty;

1.4proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 325F.

1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6Section 1. **[325F.812] CELLULAR TELEPHONE CASES.**

1.7Subdivision 1. **Certain cellular telephone cases; prohibition.** A person is prohibited

1.8from purchasing, possessing, importing, manufacturing, selling, holding for sale, or

1.9distributing a cellular telephone case, stand, or cover that is a facsimile of or reasonably

1.10appears to be a firearm, including but not limited to a pistol or revolver.

1.11Subd. 2. **Enforcement.** This section may be enforced by the attorney general under

1.12section 8.31, but a court may not impose a civil penalty of more than \$500 for a violation

1.13of this section.
