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S.F. No. 3351 – Insurance Mandate for Orthotic and Prosthetic Devices (as amended by the A-4)

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S.F. 3351 requires private and public health plans to provide coverage for orthotic and prosthetic devices. The bill defines "accredited facility," "orthosis," "orthotics," "prothesis," and "prosthetics."

The bill allows a health plan company to perform utilization reviews to determine whether to deny coverage related to prosthetics or orthotics. Utilization review determinations must be issued in a nondiscriminatory manner.

The bill provides medical assistance coverage for eyeglasses and dentures if prescribed by a doctor. The bill provides medical assistance coverage for orthotic and prosthetic devices, subject to several requirements and restrictions.
