

1.1 Senator moves to amend S.F. No. 3511 as follows:

1.2 Page 1, line 10, after "3," insert "and county-based purchasing plans"

1.3 Page 2, line 5, reinstate the stricken language

1.4 Page 2, line 6, reinstate everything before "~~that~~" and before "must" insert "and
1.5 county-based purchasing plans"

1.6 Page 3, after line 12, insert:

1.7 "(c) A health plan that is a high-deductible health plan in conjunction with a health
1.8 savings account must include cost-sharing for the coverage required under this section at
1.9 the minimum level necessary to preserve the enrollee's ability to make tax-exempt
1.10 contributions and withdrawals from the health savings account as provided in section 223
1.11 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986."

1.12 Page 3, line 14, before the period, insert ", and county-based purchasing plans"

1.13 Page 3, line 25, after the comma, insert "and county-based purchasing plans"

1.14 Page 4, line 6, before "The" insert "(a)"

1.15 Page 4, after line 9, insert:

1.16 "(b) A health plan that is a high-deductible health plan in conjunction with a health
1.17 savings account must include cost-sharing for the coverage required under this section at
1.18 the minimum level necessary to preserve the enrollee's ability to make tax-exempt
1.19 contributions and withdrawals from the health savings account as provided in section 223
1.20 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986."

1.21 Page 5, after line 24, insert:

1.22 "(e) A health plan that is a high-deductible health plan in conjunction with a health
1.23 savings account must include cost-sharing for the coverage required under this section at
1.24 the minimum level necessary to preserve the enrollee's ability to make tax-exempt
1.25 contributions and withdrawals from the health savings account as provided in section 223
1.26 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986."

1.27 Page 5, after line 26, insert:

1.28 "Sec. 5. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 256B.0625, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.29 to read:

1.30 Subd. 72. **Prenatal, maternity, and postnatal care.** (a) Medical assistance covers
1.31 prenatal care that meets the requirements in section 62A.047. Medical assistance coverage

- 2.1 must meet the requirements that would otherwise apply to a health plan under section
2.2 62A.047.
- 2.3 (b) Medical assistance covers maternity care that meets the requirements in section
2.4 62A.0411. Medical assistance coverage must meet the requirements that would otherwise
2.5 apply to a health plan under section 62A.0411.
- 2.6 (c) Medical assistance covers postnatal care that meets the requirements in section
2.7 62Q.521. Medical assistance coverage must meet the requirements that would otherwise
2.8 apply to a health plan under section 62Q.521."
- 2.9 Renumber the sections in sequence and correct the internal references
- 2.10 Amend the title accordingly
